

All of Deakin's allied health programs are professionally accredited, and students will have access to cutting-edge teaching facilities in the purpose-built, \$53 million Regional Community Health Hub (REACH).

Architecture

Deakin's Geelong Waterfront Campus offers a dynamic study environment with a contemporary design studio, fully-equipped workshop, rapid prototyping and a building performance lab. CAMPUSES & ACCOMMODATION



Melbourne Burwood Campus

The Melbourne Burwood Campus is Deakin's largest and has a lively and diverse culture. It has striking modern architecture and open and inviting spaces for socialising and studying.

The campus features a professional motion capture lab; dance, drama and television studios; food nutrition lab; and IT gaming facilities. It is a short trip from the centre of Melbourne, giving students access to the best of city living combined with a friendly community atmosphere.



Geelong Waterfront Campus

The Geelong Waterfront Campus is positioned in the centre of Geelong's central business district. Students love the central location, as well as the creative, modern areas to meet with friends or study.

The campus is home to Deakin's architecture and creative arts studios, as well as nursing and health teaching facilities, including a purpose-built occupational therapy laboratory. The campus is also home to excellent facilities for business and law students.



Geelong Wauran Ponds Campus

Set on expansive, landscaped grounds, Geelong Wauran Ponds is Deakin's second largest campus. Wauran Ponds is home to the Deakin Medical School and Geelong Innovation Precinct – a collection of research centres exploring the latest in advanced fields like nanotechnology and biotechnology.

The campus is a short trip from the Australia's southern coast surf beaches. And students have the ability to frequently catch public transport to the centre of Geelong and Melbourne.



Warrnambool Campus

Deakin's Warrnambool Campus is set on the banks of the picturesque Hopkins River, close to surf beaches and popular tourist attractions. The Warrnambool Campus is a close-knit community: a place where students and lecturers have the opportunity to get to know each other. This sense of community extends to the whole of Warrnambool, providing support to new students in a relaxed, friendly atmosphere.

Being located near a number of unique aquatic environments makes the Warrnambool Campus an ideal location for marine biology studies.



Cloud Campus

Deakin's Cloud Campus (online) enables students to take part in classes and seminars, and chat with other students and academic staff. All cloud students are provided with the latest digital tools and tailored support needed to succeed.

Cloud Campus students have the flexibility to study anywhere at any time. As a Cloud Campus student you are taught by the same lecturers and tutors as campus students, get remote access to all of Deakin's student support services and activities, and connect with specialist careers and language advisers to help you with course direction and study skills.



Live where you study

Deakin has on-campus accommodation at our Melbourne, Geelong and Warrnambool campuses. Living on campus offers a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in the Deakin experience and make new friends.

Accommodation at Deakin provides an affordable and secure living and learning community. Across all our accommodation facilities, residents have exclusive access to landscaped courtyards, indoor and outdoor communal cooking and entertaining facilities, recreational spaces, study rooms, free laundries, secure bike storage and movie rooms.

HOW TO APPLY

Once you have selected a degree and checked all entry requirements, applying to study at Deakin is easy. You can apply at any time throughout the year, and Deakin's international admissions team is always ready to quickly process applications.

How do I apply?

Once you have prepared all the necessary documentation, you can submit your application using one of the following methods:

- **Applying by mail or email**
After completing the relevant application forms you can either mail or email your application to Deakin.
- **Applying through a representative**
Deakin has a network of experienced representatives around the world who can help you submit an application. Talk with your agent about submitting your application to Deakin.
- **Applying online**
Using Deakin's online application process is quick and easy. After submitting your application online, you will be asked to supply certified documentation to complete your application.

Scholarships

At Deakin, we believe everyone should have the option of going to university. There are an array of scholarships available to international students through Deakin and other parties, including the Australian Government.

Deakin scholarships include:

- **Deakin Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship** offers a 100% or 50% tuition fee reduction for the duration of your course, among other benefits.
- **Deakin International Scholarship** offers 25% tuition fee reduction for the duration of your course.
