TO ENTER:

Complete an entry form and submit a 500 word essay in English on the topic:

Choose a significant historical event in the last 60 years and explain why, in your opinion, it was important.

The event can be a political event, the development of an idea, discovery or invention, a moment that expressed a change in society, or a natural event. It may be either national or global, and either a single moment or an event which took place over a period of time. Most importantly, the essay must express your own ideas in your own words, and not be copied directly from any source such as the Internet.

- The scholarship includes all meals, accommodation, tours and activities for the duration of the program.
